Funding Opportunities for Graduate Students, Post-Docs and Faculty

DAAD New York



Study Scholarship - Eligibility Criteria

- ▶ Graduating seniors, graduate students and recent graduates may apply
- ▶ All academic fields
- ▶ German language ability should be commensurate with needs
- ▶ US or Canadian citizenship (foreigners must have studied 2 years at a North American university)
- ▶ Applicants must not be resident in Germany for more than one year

Terms of Award

- ▶ Support for one or two years of study in Germany
- ▶ Can be used to earn a Master's degree – some taught in English – at a German university
- ▶ Monthly stipend approx. 750 €, plus health insurance and travel subsidy
- ▶ Application deadline: students of the performing/visual arts: **November 1**, all other fields **November 15**





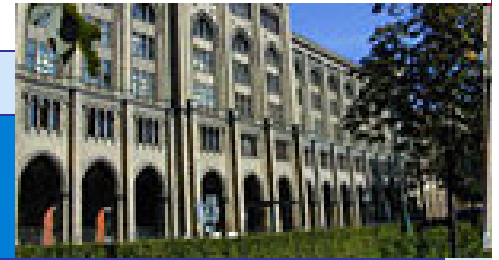
Eligibility Requirements – Research Grant

- ▶ PhD candidates and postdocs
- ▶ Enrolled full-time in a North American university (if not planning to do the whole doctoral program in Germany)
- ▶ Only ABD candidates can apply for a duration less than 10 months
- ▶ US or Canadian citizenship (foreigners must have studied 2 years at a North American university)
- ▶ Applicants must not be resident in Germany for more than one year
- ▶ PhD candidates and postdocs must have well-defined research project (also to complete PhD in Germany)
- ▶ Invitation by host institution essential

Terms of Award

- ▶ 1 to 10 months (with the possibility of an extension)
- ▶ Monthly stipend approx. 1000 €, plus health insurance and travel subsidy
- ▶ Application deadline: **November 15** (long-term/short-term), **May 15** (short-term)

For Study scholarship and Research Grant

- ▶ Check if your university is a DAAD partner university (you can find a list of our partners online)

- ▶ If “YES”, contact the DAAD campus coordinator and submit your application to the coordinator before the university deadline
- ▶ If “No”, submit your application directly to the NY office

RISE *professional*

- ▶ 6-12 week summer placements in industry internships with leading German companies.
- ▶ German requirements depend on the nature of the internship.
- ▶ Scholarships and housing assistance are provided.
- ▶ **NEW**: 2 week intensive language course for RISE and RISE *pro* participants with little or no German

Summer Courses

- ▶ Summer courses at German Universities for grad students
- ▶ Hundreds of courses to choose from
- ▶ Scholarships only for courses taught in German – 2 years minimum language requirement
- ▶ Application deadline: **December 15**

Intensive Language Courses

- ▶ Learn German for 8 weeks at top language institutes in Germany
- ▶ Any field except English, German, or other modern language or literature
- ▶ Must have 3 semesters of college German
- ▶ Application Deadline: **December 15**



German Studies Research Grant

- ▶ Short-term research: one to two months
- ▶ Advanced Undergraduate and Graduate students
- ▶ Candidates are nominated by their department and/or program chair
- ▶ Two years of college German required
- ▶ Application Deadline: **November 1**, and **May 1**

EMGIP – Bundestag internship

- ▶ 2 months internship in the German Bundestag
- ▶ Students in the field of political sciences, social sciences, international relations, law, German
- ▶ Students must be fluent in German
- ▶ Application deadline: **November 1**

Faculty Research Visit Grant



- ▶ 1 to 3 months
- ▶ All academic fields
- ▶ Grants awarded for specific research
- ▶ Additional funding for former DAAD-one-year grantees, called re-invitation program
- ▶ Application deadline: **November 15**, and **May 15**

Visiting professorships

- ▶ Guest teaching assignments in Germany
- ▶ Funding goes to the host institution, professors are paid by host institution according to German salary schemes
- ▶ Invitation from German institution necessary
- ▶ Application deadline: **January 15** for winter semester, **July 15**, for following summer semester

Further options

▶ Short-term Lectureships

- ▶ Financial support for North American Universities hosting a German scholars

▶ Conference Funding in German Studies

- ▶ Co-funding to organize workshops, seminars and conferences

▶ Group Study Visits

- ▶ Financial support for information visits to Germany
- ▶ Groups of 10-15 students and duration of 7-12 days

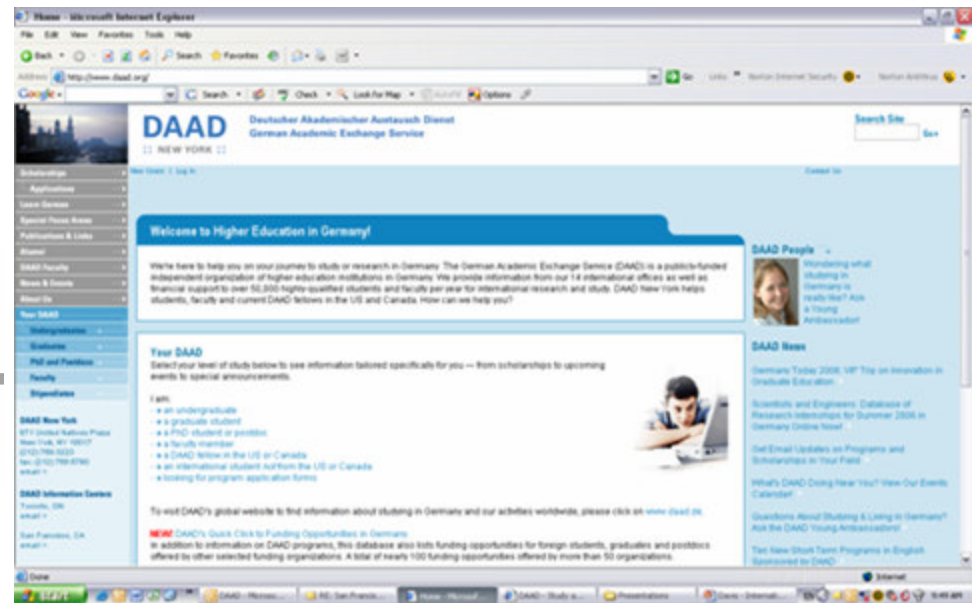
