Intercultural Communication and European Studies (ICEUS) - International M.A. Programme

The programme seeks to prepare university graduates for careers in supranational or national organisations that are active internationally, especially in Europe. During this programme, participants will develop a profound knowledge of the European Union's complex organisational structures, and the ability to communicate effectively with speakers of other languages and other cultural backgrounds. In addition, students will get familiar with the background, frame and future perspectives of European Integration. The students also acquire the means to deal with the special challenges of the enlargement of the European Union and the increasing economic and political significance of the European Union in a global context.



Programme Overview:

- Programme duration: 4 semesters (24 months)
- Programme start: Winter semester (October 1)
- Credits: 120 ECTS
- Language of instruction: English and German
- International study group of 30 participants per year
- Internship of ten weeks is part of the programme
- Study trips to Brussels and Straßbourg
- Admission requirements: Bachelor's degree or equivalent (180-210 ECTS), certification of good proficiency in German and English

Application deadline: 15 May for applicants from outside the EU; 15 July for EU applicants
