DAAD IC San Francisco Office Change

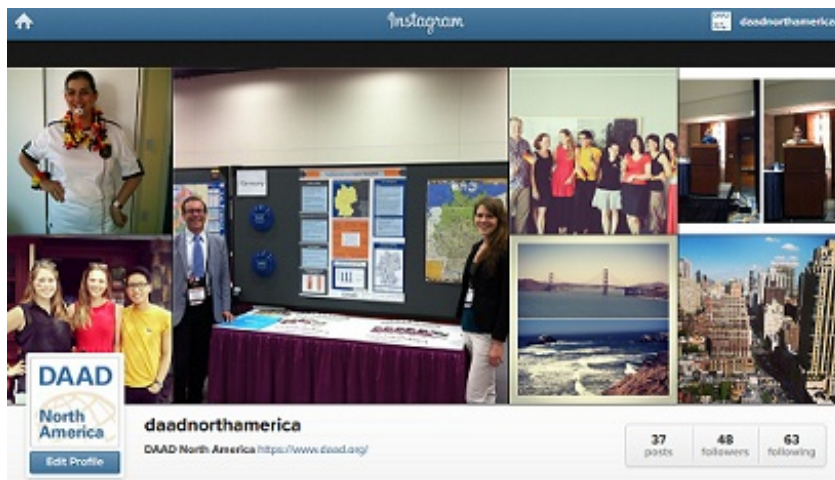
