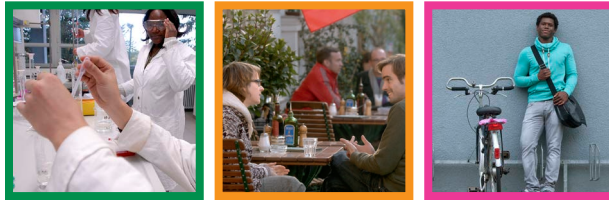
### What is DAAD?

### RISE Germany - Research Internships in Science and Engineering

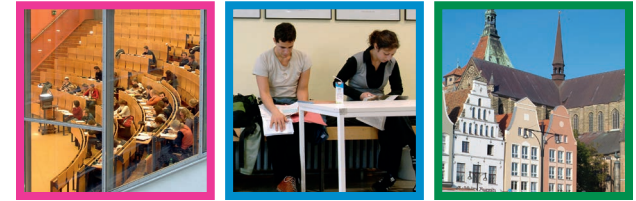
