#### What is the DAAD?

- German national agency for international academic cooperation and exchange
- Independent association of German universities



- DAAD provides
  - Scholarships and grants (to academics at <u>all</u> stages and in <u>all</u> disciplines)
  - Information and counseling about studying & research in Germany
  - Support for internationalization of German universities
  - The study of German language and culture abroad



### **DAAD Funding**

- Funding for
  - ⇒ study abroad
  - **⇒** internships
  - ⇒ senior thesis research
- Monthly stipend or lump sum
- Open to students in all fields
- Previous knowledge of German not required, but advantageous
- Health insurance
- Some travel reimbursement
- All-Grantees meeting



# Study Scholarship for Graduates

#### www.daad.org/gradstudy

- Scholarship to support pursuit of a Master's degree at a German university (up to two years)
- German language ability should be commensurate with needs
- Final-year undergrads may apply
- 60 awarded annually
- ₹ 750/month; health and liability insurance; travel stipend
- Deadline: November 4
