Top Reasons for Pursuing Graduate Studies in Germany



- 1. Top degrees recognized around the world
- 2. Many programs offered in English
- 3. Studying internationally broadens the borders of any field
- 4. Low tuition fees, or none at all
- 5. Welcome & support structures in place

Research-oriented Master's Degree Professional Master's Degree

Qualified students holding a Bachelor's degree may be recommended for a PhD fast-track, linking Master and PhD programs (if applicable)

Language Requirements



International Master Programs

- Growing number of programs taught in English
- No proof of German skills required
- Proficiency in English does not need to be certified if BA from institution with English as official language or if native speaker

German-taught Master Programs

- Submit proof of language proficiency
- German Language Certificates,
 e.g.:

"Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang" (DSH) "TestDaF" (can be taken in the US, www.testdaf.de)

Other languages may be required for certain subject fields; check which language certificates are accepted by university

Applying to a Master Program



Application procedures and requirements vary (check online)

- => submit application directly to university (LMU Munich)
- => apply via the online portal Uni Assist [uni-assist.de] (FU Berlin)
- Undergraduate degree in specific fields of study required
- Submit online application form, proof of language proficiency, supporting documents (e.g. CV, transcripts of records incl. final grade, letter of motivation & reference)
- Application deadlines vary for summer semester (April-Sept) and for winter semester (Oct-Mar)

Doctorate in Germany – Different Options



Individual Doctoral Studies

Apprenticeship Model



The doctoral candidate

- ...has a supervisor
- ...is free to choose a subject
- ...has no timely limitations
- ...has no curriculum to follow

Doctoral Programs

Structured Doctorate



The doctoral candidate

- ...has a team of supervisors
- ...is integrated into a network
- ...has a time frame (3 years)
- ...has a complementary curriculum
- ...has a supervision agreement

86 % of all doctoral candidates

14% of all doctoral candidates

Applying for individual doctoral studies



Steps:

- Independent search for a supervisor
- Receipt of a confirmation of supervision from the supervisor or conclusion of a supervision agreement
- Request for acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the examination office
- Receipt of a notification of acceptance as a doctoral candidate
- Enrollment: Applicants with a foreign university degree: Submitting a request for university admission to the International Office

Funding: Discuss funding options with supervisor

Applying for a doctorate in a structured program



Steps:

- Selection of a suitable doctoral program
- Application by respective deadline
- Participation in the competitive selection process
- In the event of successful application, the program provides support in the further administrative steps (e.g. applying for the additionally required acceptance as a doctoral candidate at the faculty, and possibly in the enrollment process).

Funding: check what kind of financial support program can offer / position in a structured program, grant/scholarships



Cost of living and studying



Berlin

- Mostly tuition-free programs
- Semester fee €310 (includes public transportation ticket)
- Mandatory health Insurance for students (€80/month)
- Average costs of living about €700/month (rent, food, phone fees)

Munich

- Mostly tuition-free programs
- Semester fee €120 (includes basic public transportation, excludes IsarCard €189)
- Mandatory health insurance for students (€80/month)
- Average cost of living about €900/month (rent, food, phone fees)

Accommodation: Start your hunt early!








Freie Universität - Profile

- Selected twice as a German University of Excellence
- THE Ranking: from rank 151 in 2011 to 72 in 2016
- Unique: "Area Studies" on North America, Latin America, Eastern Europe, East Asia, Muslim Cultures & Societies
- Further foci within the Excellence Initiative: Ancient Civilizations, Literary Studies, Mathematics, Nanoscale Materials, Neuroscience, Oncology, Regenerative Therapies
- Over 30,500 students and 4300 doctoral candidates
- About 105 master's degree programs (including 24 taught in English); 50 doctoral degree programs
- 20 % of int'l students in master's programs (17 % of the students overall), 32 % int'l doctoral candidates









Integrated Master & Phd Training In Neurosciences / Example





The Graduate School of Neurosciences (GSN) offers the opportunity for especially qualified applicants holding a neuroscience related bachelor's degree to directly enter the PhD program. Students requiring preparatory training may be admitted to the fast-track PhD program. During the first two semesters of the fasttrack program (preparatory year), students receive basic training in neuroscience, which is in close collaboration with the GSN master's programs (Neurosciences and Neurocognitive Psychology).


LMU Graduate Center – Doctoral Studies
